Your private AI agent platform

From download to first sign-in — in a few minutes

Private AI, built and run on your terms.

Before you begin

Mili installs with a single guided command. The installer checks your machine, sets up Docker for you if it isn't already there, downloads the Mili engine, and starts it — no specialist required. Everything runs on hardware you own.

What you need

- **A computer you own** running Windows 10/11, macOS (Apple Silicon), Linux (x86-64), or a Raspberry Pi 4/5.
- **An internet connection** for the one-time download of the Mili engine (about 1.2 GB).
- **A few gigabytes of free disk** and roughly five to ten minutes, most of it unattended.
- **Permission to install software** — you'll be asked to approve one elevation prompt when Docker is set up.

Docker is handled for you

Mili runs inside Docker. On Windows and macOS the installer sets up **Docker Desktop** automatically; on Linux and Raspberry Pi it sets up **Docker Engine**. You don't need to install or configure Docker yourself, and you don't need a Docker account.

The five-minute path

- Open the download page and copy your one-line install command.
- Paste it into a terminal and let it run.
- Open Mili in your browser, sign in, set your password, and activate your subscription.

The rest of this guide walks through each step in detail.

Install Mili

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Open the download page

In your web browser, go to www.agent-qc.net/downloads. The page detects your operating system and shows the exact command to run. **Click the command to copy it.**

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Open a terminal and paste the command

Windows: click Start, type `powershell`, open **Windows PowerShell**, then paste and press Enter:

```
irm https://www.agent-qc.net/downloads/install.ps1 | iex
```

macOS, Linux, or Raspberry Pi: open **Terminal**, paste and press Enter (you'll be asked for your password):

```
curl -fsSL https://www.agent-qc.net/downloads/install.sh | sudo bash
```

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Let it set up Docker and download Mili

The installer takes it from here. It checks for Docker, installs Docker Desktop or Docker Engine if needed, accepts the Docker terms on your behalf, then downloads the Mili engine (about 1.2 GB) and starts it.

If a Docker **"Welcome to Docker"** sign-in window appears, click **Skip** — Mili doesn't need a Docker account. When you're prompted to allow the Docker installer to make changes, accept it. Wait until the log shows that Mili is running.

Other ways to run the installer

Platform	Command
macOS / Linux / Raspberry Pi	<code>curl -fsSL https://www.agent-qc.net/downloads/install.sh sudo bash</code>
Windows (WSL2)	<code>wsl bash -c "curl -fsSL https://www.agent-qc.net/downloads/install.sh sudo bash"</code>

By installing Mili you agree to the Docker Desktop terms of service and the Agentic Quebec Inc. terms of service.

Open Mili and sign in

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Open Mili in your browser

Once the installer finishes, go to `https://localhost:5001`.

Your browser will warn that "**Your connection isn't private**" (NET::ERR_CERT_AUTHORITY_INVALID). This is expected: Mili secures the connection with a certificate it creates on your own machine, which your browser doesn't recognise. Because the address is your own computer, it's safe to continue. Click **Advanced**, then **Proceed to localhost**.

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Sign in for the first time

On the Mili sign-in screen, use the default credentials:

Username `admin` Password `password`

Then click **Sign In**.

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Change your password right away

Open **Settings** → **Authentication** and set a strong password before doing anything else. This is the single most important step to keep your instance private.

Why the certificate warning is normal

Mili lives entirely on your machine. The warning appears for every locally hosted service that uses HTTPS — it is not a sign that anything is wrong. Your data never leaves your computer.

Activate your subscription

After signing in you'll see a banner that reads "**No active subscription.**" Click **Subscribe now** to open the Subscription page, then choose one of the options below. The plan is **Mili — \$600 CAD / month** per seat, where each seat is one device.

Set up a new organization

- Enter an **organization billing email** (optional).
- Choose your **number of seats** — one seat per device. You can change this anytime in the billing portal.
- Click **Subscribe — \$600 CAD / month** and complete checkout. You can apply a discount code at checkout.

Join an existing organization

If your organization already subscribes, enter the join code your administrator shared with you (for example **FGPT-XXXXXXX**) and click **Join**.

Restore a previous subscription

Reinstalling, or moving to a new device? Enter the email used previously under **Restore subscription** to transfer your existing subscription across.

What's included

Each seat includes a **\$600 CAD credit** per period to spend on tokens and embeddings (RAG) through the GenAI gateway. Credits don't roll over. To discuss higher limits or other options, contact sales@agent-qc.net.

You're ready

Mili is installed, secured, and subscribed. From here you can connect your first integrations, set up scheduled tasks, and point Mili at your own documents — all from the **Settings** and **Contacts** menus at the top of the app.

If something doesn't go to plan

What you see	What to do
"Your connection isn't private" at localhost	Expected. Click Advanced → Proceed to localhost . Mili uses a self-signed certificate on your own machine.
Docker asks you to sign in	Click Skip . Mili does not require a Docker account.
localhost:5001 won't load	Make sure Docker is running (the whale icon in your tray/menu bar), then wait a minute for Mili to finish starting and refresh.
Windows: install fails early	WSL2 may not be enabled. Open an admin PowerShell, run <code>wsl --install</code> , restart, then run the install command again.
You forgot your new password	Reset it from the host machine, or contact your administrator. Support is available from the Support menu inside Mili, or by email at support@agent-qc.net if the app is unreachable.

Where your data lives

Mili stores everything in an install folder on your machine (by default `mili` in your home directory) and in its Docker volumes. Nothing is shared with an outside tenant, and every credential is encrypted at rest.
